



## 2024 GSLL Rule Waivers

The National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) 2024 Boys Lacrosse Rules Book will be in effect for the GSLL Boys Lacrosse 2024 season with the exception of the waivers listed below:

- 1. Rule 1, Section 2: The Field
  - a. Article 1: To the extent that is reasonable, teams are expected to mark fields with lines and dimensions as defined in this article
    - i. Dimensions due to local conditions dimensions may be altered to fit the field
    - ii. Lines
      - 1. Except for limit lines, all other lines are required
      - 2. DELETE NOTE and PENALTY, requiring a clearly marked center line that runs the entire width of the field. While it is desired that teams follow this provision, even with temporary markings so players can clearly identify the centerline, they are not required.
- 2. Rule 1, Section 3: Goals and Goal Lines
  - a. Articles 1&2: Any manufactured metal lacrosse goal may be used
  - b. Article 3: A "legal goal" under this waiver is defined, as stated above, "any manufactured metal lacrosse goal."
- 3. Rule 1, Section 9: Player Equipment
  - a. Article 1 (a): To the extent that is reasonable, teams are expected to have the same color helmet. Due to circumstances beyond the control of the team/player, a different color helmet may be used
  - b. Article 1 (h): To the extent that is reasonable, teams are expected to have the same color jersey. Due to circumstances beyond the control of the team/player, the jerseys do not have to be exact, but must be of the similar shade of color
  - c. Article 1 (h8): To the extent that is reasonable, the home team shall wear white jerseys and the visiting team shall wear non-white jerseys. However, if agreeable by both head coaches, both teams may wear non-white jerseys.
  - d. Article 1 (j): To the extent that is reasonable, players on the same teams are expected to wear shorts of the same dominant color. Due to circumstances beyond the control of the team/player, the player may wear shorts of a similar shade of color.
